India Stonemart 2026, the 13th edition of the International Stone Industry Exhibition, was held from February 5-8, 2026, at the Jaipur Exhibition and Convention Centre (JECC), Sitapura, Jaipur. This historic edition, themed "Stone for Sustainability," was organized by the Centre for Development of Stones (CDOS) and RIICO, with Laghu Udyog Bharati (LUB) serving as a co-organizer.

The event served as a global confluence of heritage and modernity, attracting a total footfall of 27,256 visitors and generating business inquiries worth approximately ₹3,200 crore. Key highlights included the launch of a multilingual official website in 26 languages and the introduction of a dedicated digital mobile application.

The exhibition emphasized Rajasthan's role as a global stone hub, showcasing all varieties of dimensional stones and its contribution to iconic national structures like Rashtrapati Bhavan and the Parliament House.



INAUGURATION



The much-anticipated India StoneMart 2026 was ceremoniously inaugurated on 5 February 2026 at the Jaipur Exhibition & Convention Centre (JECC) in Sitapura, Jaipur.

The event was inaugurated by Shri Bhajanlal Sharma, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Rajasthan. He emphasized the "Vocal for Local" vision, highlighting that Rajasthan's stone is not just a resource but a cultural identity used in iconic structures like the Ram Mandir in Ayodhya, the Rashtrapati Bhavan and the Parliament House.

Speaking on the occasion, Chief Minister Shri Bhajanlal Sharma described India StoneMart 2026 not merely as a trade fair but as a confluence of culture, craftsmanship, and industrial strength that showcases the heritage and future potential of India's stone sector.

Shri Bhajanlal Sharma emphasized that Rajasthan stone is "both our heritage and our future." He prioritized MSME encouragement, worker safety, and fair wages.

A key highlight of India StoneMart 2026 was its strong digital push, with organisers launching a dedicated mobile app and a multilingual website designed to streamline networking, facilitate updates and enhance engagement between exhibitors, global buyers, architects and design professionals.
